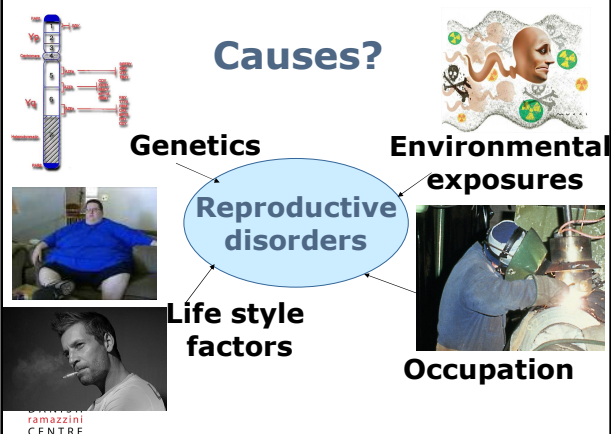
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Why study reproductive disorders ?

- Approximately 15% of all couples does not conceive within one year of trying
- More than 6% of Danish children are conceived after IVF treatment.
- Ultimate causes of infertility for most couples unknown

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Causes?
